## At the 2012 Cross-Cultural Healthcare Symposium

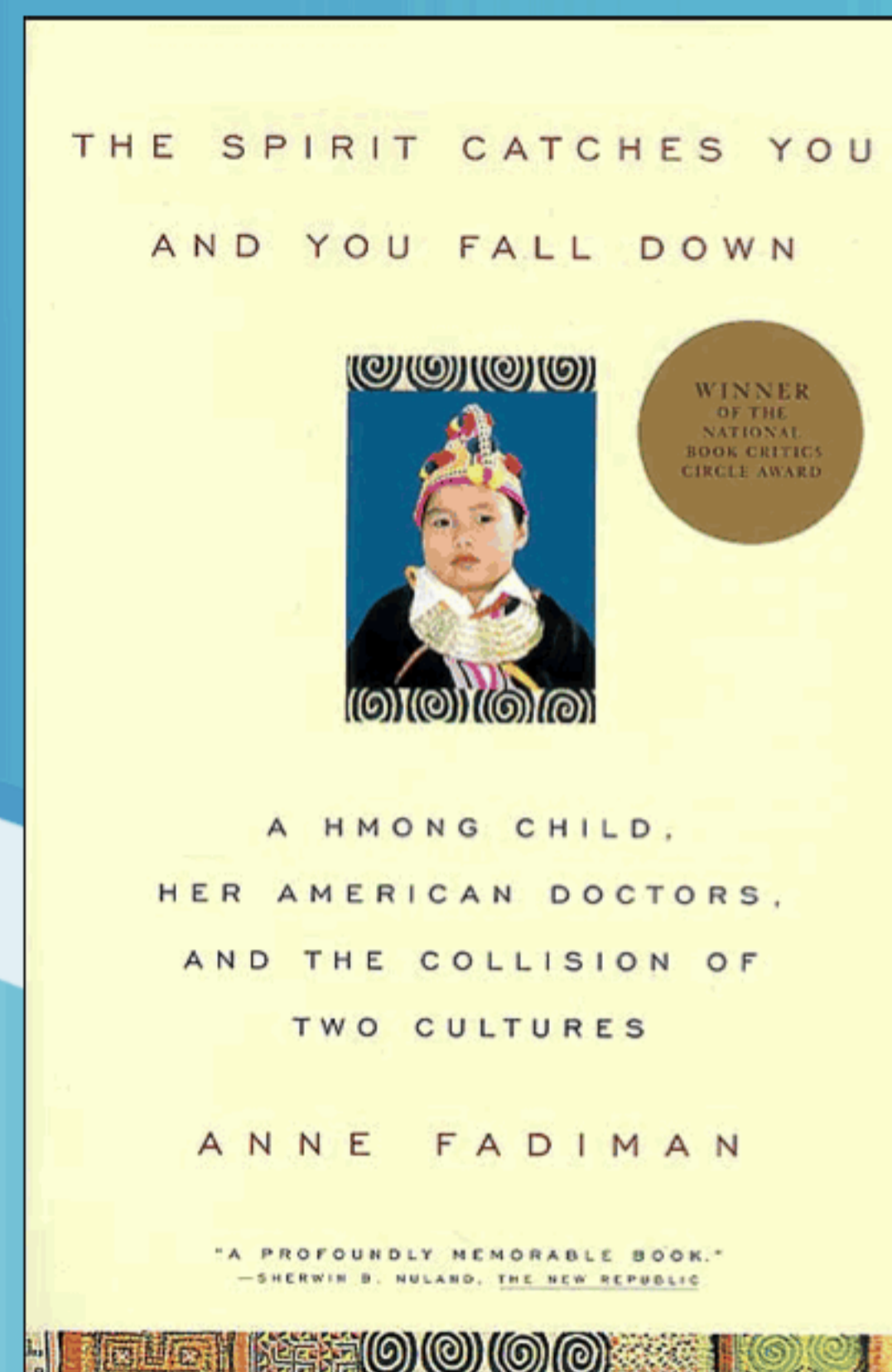

Fadiman's sensitive, incisive treatment of the unbreachable gulf between the Hmong and American medical systems won her a National Book Critics' Circle Award. The book continues to be taught at universities both as

literary journalism and as a casebook for crosscultural sensitivity in general; it is also widely read by medical practitioners who wish to offer more effective care to patients from other cultures.
