- I. Introduction
 - A. The following are required by the Higher Education Act.
- II. Student Verification
 - A. As an institution that offers distance education, INMED establishes that the student who registers in a distance education course or program is the same student who participates in and completes the program and receives the academic credit. Examples of such methods include:
 - 1. Student identity upon application:
 - a. Government-issued ID
 - b. Headshot
 - c. Passport
 - 2. A secure login and password
 - 3. Proctored examinations
 - B. In carrying out these processes, INMED protects student privacy and will notify students at the time of registration or enrollment of any projected additional student charges associated with the verification of student identity.
